

# Sixth Grade Rules, Consequences, and Responsibilities.

## General Classroom Rules

1. You will treat others with respect and kindness.
2. You will be responsible with assignments and all materials.
3. You will be truthful and accept responsibility for your actions.
4. You will raise your hand for permission to speak during whole group instruction.

## Study Team Rules

1. You are responsible for your own behavior.
2. You must try to help anyone in your study team who asks.
3. Only when **ALL** study team members have the **SAME** question may you ask the teacher for help.
4. You must use study team voices

## Consequences

1. Personal Warning
2. Verbal Warning / Logical consequence
3. Written apology that must be signed by parents
4. Referral/ Detention
5. Temporary removal from classroom to the office

Note: The order of these consequences can change according to the severity of the behavior.

## Responsibilities

### **Morning:**

1. Make your lunch choice.
2. Unpack your backpack at your desk and place backpack in cubby.
3. Prepare for the day (organize pencils, reading books, assignments, and agenda with weekly evaluation).
4. Begin **reading**.

### **Continuous:**

1. Record assignments in agenda as given by teacher.
2. Complete all assignments on time.
3. Write name, number, and date on all assignments.
4. Perform your job.
5. Keep your work space clean and organized.
8. Use your time wisely.
9. Respect the attention signal.
10. Work on on-going assignments. When assignments are **all** complete, read.
